

Facility & Equipment Manager Position Description

The Facility & Equipment Manager creates a safe, healthy environment at our SF1 facility so that the team can operate at optimal performance and effectiveness. The duties for this role are carried out during normal business hours, but on-call for emergencies is also required.

Key Support Person – Operations Lead

The primary responsibilities of this position are:

## Infrastructure 100%

- Maintain all building infrastructure, utilities and equipment including generators, heating system, production equipment, sprinklers, elevators, drains, alarm systems, compressors etc.
- Research and bring proposals for maintenance, replacement, repair of equipment to leadership for approval
- Troubleshoot any issues that come up at any time including after hours
- Coordinate all contractors for equipment maintenance and repair, snow removal, lawn maintenance, waste removal (including sharps, biohazardous material etc.), cleaning, pest control etc.
- Support IT in implementing and maintaining building and equipment security system and programs
- Purchases all building maintenance supplies according to Resource Management Policy
- Ensure optimal environmental health and safety of the facility at all times
- Complete safety inspections and safety orientations, hold monthly safety huddles and record minutes; record, investigate and coordinate solutions for safety incidents
- Manage building security including maintaining records, issuing access cards and keys, maintaining locks etc.
- Assist R&D and production teams with processes as needed
- Support on-going development and implementation of resource management programs to measure and optimize energy efficiency and sustainability
